GENERAL NOTES

- This game marked the 14th time for Ole Miss to play on Halloween ... The Rebels are 6-7-1 in these encounters ... Ole Miss is 4-4-1 in Halloween day games.
- Ole Miss has opened SEC play 2-3 for the second straight year.
- The Rebels' 24-point third quarter deficit is the team's largest of the year.

OFFENSIVE NOTES

- Senior Dexter McCluster topped 100 rushing yards for the second straight game and second time in his career ... His 186 is the most since BenJarvus Green-Ellis ran for 226 yards against Missouri in 2007 ... McClusters' 79-yard TD run marked the longest rush of his career and his second rushing TD of the season ... McCluster also hauled in four catches for 17 yards and exceeded 200 all-purpose yards for the second straight week.
- Senior WR Shay Hodge notched his second 100-yard receiving game of the year and third of his career with seven catches for 107 yards ... It marks his third game of the season with at least seven receptions.
- Junior QB Jevan Snead finished 16-of-35 for 175 yards, one TD and two interceptions ... Snead failed to reach 200 passing yards and throw for multiple TDs for the first time in three games ... He has thrown for at least two scores in all but three games this season.
- Sophomore RB Brandon Bolden collected four catches for 46 yards, including a career-long 43-yarder ... His 12 rushing yards is a season low.
- Senior FB Andy Hartmann hauled in his third TD catch of the year with a seven-yarder on the opening drive of the game.
- Ole Miss' 94-yard drive to open the game was the team's longest of the year.

DEFENSIVE NOTES

- Ole Miss surrendered season highs in points (33) and yards (401).
- Junior S Johnny Brown topped the team in tackles for the third time this season with 10 stops ... It marks his third double-digit tackle performance.
- Junior LB Jonathan Cornell collected a career-high nine tackles along with a two QB pressures.
- Senior S Kendrick Lewis finished with seven total tackles, one sack, one forced fumble and one pass break-up.
- Senior DE Greg Hardy posted a pair of sacks to raise his team-high season total to 5.0 in seven games of action.
- Ole Miss was credited with eight TFLs, including three sacks.
- Auburn's first field goal marked just the second score Ole Miss has allowed in the first quarter this year ... The Rebels have surrendered only six points in the opening stanza this season.

SPECIAL TEAMS NOTES

- In only his fourth game handling returns, freshman Jesse Grandy notched his second kickoff return for a TD with his 82-yarder in the third quarter ... Grandy is only the third Rebel to return two kickoffs for TDs in the same season and the first since John Avery in 1996. The other is Vernon Studdard in 1970.
- Senior K Joshua Shene missed his first field goal of the year at the end of the first quarter from 44 yards, and is now 8-for-9 for the season ... He had been the only remaining SEC kicker that was perfect in field goals ... In the third quarter, Shene had a PAT blocked for the second time this season.
- Freshman P Tyler Campbell notched his fourth punt of 50-plus yards with a 53-yarder ... He finished with a 43.7-yard average in six attempts with two inside the 20 yardline.

- The pregame flight was made by Nova from the ramp above section 46 in the northwest corner of the stadium.
- Auburn team captains were QB Chris Todd, DE Antonio Coleman and CB Walter McFadden.
- Auburn won the toss and deferred to the second half. Ole Miss received to start the game, and Auburn defended the north end zone.
- Kickoff was at 11:21 a.m. CT.
- Attendance was announced as 84,756.

TEAM NOTES

- Auburn now leads the all-time series 25-9, and holds a 12-2 edge in games played in Jordan-Hare Stadium.
- Auburn is now 2-0 all-time against teams ranked 24th in the Associated Press Top 25 poll. The other victory was a 32-29 victory over Army in the 1996 Independence Bowl.
- Auburn's victory was its first over a nationally-ranked team since a 23-20 victory over Clemson in the 2007 Chick-fil-A Bowl ... It was also Auburn's first win over a nationally ranked SEC team since a 27-17 win over second-ranked Florida in 2006.
- Auburn scored 33 points, which is the most scored against Ole Miss this season. In fact, Auburn scored more points in the third quarter (23) than any team had in an entire game this season. The most points scored against Ole Miss prior to today's game was 22 by Alabama.
- Auburn's 23 points in the third quarter are the most in a third quarter by the Tigers since records became available beginning in 1967.
- Auburn has now won 54 consecutive games when scoring 30 or more points in a game. The last time Auburn lost a game when scoring at least 30 points was in 1996, when the Tigers dropped a 56-49 contest to Georgia in four overtimes ... Auburn has scored over 30 points 278 times in its history and is 274-4 in those contests.
- Auburn came from behind to win for the fifth time in its sixth victories this season. Auburn trailed 7-0 in the first quarter.
- Auburn is now bowl eligible with six victories. The Tigers have been to 34 prior bowl games, which is 16th most in NCAA history.
- Auburn finished with 401 yards of total offense. It marked the Tigers' sixth game this season with at least 400 yards of offense.
- Ole Miss scored first on a 7-yard pass to end the opening drive. The Tigers are now 3-2 when their opponent scores first.
- Auburn's 90-yard scoring drive in the second quarter was the Tigers' second-longest scoring drive of the year. Auburn had a 98-yard scoring drive in the season opener against Louisiana Tech.
- Auburn led 10-7 at the half. The Tigers are now 5-1 this season when leading at the half.
- Auburn held Ole Miss to seven first-half points, marking the third time in the last five games that the Tigers allowed seven or fewer points in the opening half.
- Auburn's 35-second scoring drive in the third quarter was the ninth touchdown drive that took less than one minute for the Tigers this season.
- Auburn scored its third defensive touchdown this season and fourth non-offensive touchdown when Walter McFadden returned an interception 29 yards for a touchdown.
- Auburn recorded its third blocked kick this season when Antonio Coleman blocked a PAT.
- Auburn led 33-20 after three quarters. The Tigers are now 4-1 this season when leading after three quarters.

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

- Ben Tate finished with 144 yards rushing. It was his sixth 100-yard rushing game this season and the 11th of his career. His 11 100-yard rushing games are tied for seventh most in Auburn history (Kenny Irons, 2005-06) and his six 100-yard games this year are the most since Irons had eight in 2005.
- Chris Todd completed 12 passes for 212 yards. It marked his fifth 200-yard passing game of the season.
- Tate became the fifth back in Auburn history to reach 3,000 career yards rushing, and now has 3,026 for his career.

- Tate's 53-yard touchdown rush in the third quarter was Auburn's sixth touchdown play of over 50 yards this season.
- Eltoro Freeman and Daren Bates both had nine tackles ... The nine tackles was a career high for Bates.
- Wes Byrum's 36-yard field goal to end Auburn's first drive was his 41st career field goal. He is just nine field goals short of the all-time school record of 50 held by John Vaughn (2003-06).
- Chris Todd's 28-yard touchdown pass to Darvin Adams was Todd's 13th TD pass this year and the 18th of his career, and it was Adams' team-leading sixth TD catch this season.
- Kodi Burns' 14-yard touchdown pass to Tommy Trott in the third quarter was his second of the season and the sixth of his career. It was Trott's fourth career TD reception and second this year.
- Walter McFadden's 29-yard interception return for a touchdown in the third quarter was his third interception this season and the sixth of his career. It was also his second career touchdown. His first was a 93-yard interception return vs. Tennessee Tech in 2007 ... He later had a second 29-yard interception in the fourth quarter, becoming the first Auburn player since Jonathan Wilhite against New Mexico State in 2007 to have two interceptions in a game.
- Antonio Coleman recorded his 19th and 20th career quarterback sacks in the second half, moving past Reggie Torbor (18.5 from 2000-03) for fifth in school history.
- Demond Washington returned a blocked PAT for a two-point conversion. It was Auburn's first defensive two-point conversion since 1998, when Brad Ware returned a blocked kick for two points.
- Neiko Thorpe forced a fumble in the third quarter that was recovered by Daren Bates. It was Thorpe's second career forced fumble and Bates' first career fumble recovery.

Opening statement...

"This is disappointing. It is not how we planned it. We had great preparation throughout the week. You have to give Auburn credit, they did a good job. They played very physical. I thought we had our chances. We were up-and-down the field in the first half and that first drive was beautiful. We needed at least 14 or 17 as much as we got up and down the field. (Kick returner) Jesse Grandy really gave us a shot in the arm and then (Dexter) McCluster gave us a running game which we thought we were going to win, 34-33, especially when the defense gave us a turnover. You just can't turn it over and that's what our problem was."

On getting pressure on Auburn QB Chris Todd...

"We are trying to do so many different things, cover all our bases, but I was hoping for a little more pressure."

On the play of Auburn's Antonio Coleman...

"Coleman played on a different level today. He was on a different level than what we saw on film. We had a hard time with him, then we tried to chip him a little bit. It takes away a receiver."

On the third quarter...

"It was a score-fest, just back-and-forth. I really thought when (Jesse) Grandy returned that kick, I really thought we were back in it. I thought we were there in the end when we got a couple of three-and-outs. We just didn't capitalize like we needed to."

On passing deep...

"Near the end their safeties played deep. They played a lot of two-deep so it is hard. We should have gone deep earlier. We were running the ball so well and getting five or six-yards a carry. Our play action was good and that's what Jevan (Snead) does best. You just go with those things that try to give Jevan the best chance or give him something he is comfortable with. It is just disappointing. We had opportunities. I see it that we stopped ourselves. Brandon's fumble was really costly when we were inside the 30. When the defense got the fumble and we didn't get any points on that, it hurt."

On Dexter McCluster's injury...

"From the span where he was out, that really hurt us. Everything is built around him. It was spasms. You worry about how many touches you give him and how many times he can touch it with his weight and size. He got hit pretty good. He is a winner and a fighter and he will get back there as soon as he can."

On the inconsistency of the running backs...

"Right now we are putting the ball in Dexter McCluster's hands. He gives us our best chance."

On Auburn's offense...

"They got us a couple times and we had a couple of busts. We had our eyes in the wrong spots."

On Tommy Trott's touchdown...

"We weren't looking in the right place, especially the safety. We got caught up in the play action and let their guy go."

On coming into this game...

"Going on the road in the SEC, you know what to expect. It's going to be a dog-fight every single day."

On coming back from a loss...

"We have been playing well the past couple of weeks. We have been executing. I felt good about our offense and defense. We are going to win next week and then come back for a three-game stretch. We still have a chance to go to a bowl game and they know that. They got a taste of that last year and they know what that feels like."

On Auburn's pass protection...

"They mixed it up. Sometimes they would have the tight end and the back-up running back in. They did a fake and go play-action and protect, nothing we didn't know about. You have to give them credit, they executed well today. It's not what we saw from the past three weeks but they did a good job."

"Obviously, we feel very blessed to beat a very good football team today. I can't give our football team enough credit starting with our seniors and just the way they responded in a tough stretch. As we all know, that was the question that everybody wanted to know was 'How is your football team going to respond in a tough time?' I think today is a great example of the way they were going to respond. They willed that win. That was a very, very good football team that we beat tonight and our kids deserved it because they never quit fighting. It doesn't surprise anybody in our locker room that that's who they are. I thought tonight proved to a lot of people that we were going to contend and fight."

On Auburn's pass rush pressure...

"I thought that was huge. If that wasn't the best that we have been on third down defense, it was certainly one of the best. That starts with pressure up front. We did not blitz them a lot tonight. Jevan (Snead) did a nice job of scrambling out of the pocket. He got out of there a couple of times on us. It started with a four man pass rush. That is where it started. We were just good on third downs. That has been something that we needed to get better at and tonight I thought we were."

On Terrell Zachery...

"I think Terrell Zachery made two catches right now that were out of the ordinary. They were great catches. He had to go up over a guy or even two guys if I remember correctly and come down with the football. Those are the plays that we have to be able to make. Those are two big-time plays. I thought that really, really sparked us. That was the spark that we needed. That certainly is what we did earlier in the year. It was good to see us come back today and make a couple of those."

On Zac Etheridge...

"First of all, I am really proud that somebody came in and stepped up to the plate. Zac Etheridge is not only a phenomenal young man, he is a phenomenal football player. On this football team, he is a great leader. Somebody came in tonight and stepped up. It doesn't mean that we were perfect, but somebody came in and stepped in and took Zac's place. We are just so proud of Zac and obviously we will know further tomorrow as to what his status is. He is one tough, tough guy. He will rebound."

On how big Auburn's PAT return for two points was...

"If you look at that, they turned a potential 7-0 swing into a 6-2 swing which is huge. If you go back and look at us defensively right now on how many blocked kicks we've had or how many times they've come through in those situations, I am just really proud of those guys. That is kind of a down where you can take a down off. Somebody just scored on you and your body language is bad. There were a couple of new wrinkles that they threw into their offense. We felt like we got that adjusted ... some tight end movement and things that we felt like we needed to get under control. Coach (Ted) Roof did a great job, and our defensive staff did a great job seeing what it was that their plan was and then adjusting from that.”

On Walt McFadden's interceptions...

“It was huge. Walt, like I told him, there is nobody on a football team that deserves good things to happen to him. He makes them happen. He is playing coverage into a call. That interception was huge, and the field position swing was huge as far as him bringing it out. I was just proud to see him get two clutch ones today.”
